Flush examination: observing and counting during approximately 40 s psyllid adults found in tree canopy

Tapping: Tap a randomly selected branch three times with a stick (PVC pipe). Psyllid adults are counted as they fell on a clipboard above.

Soil-applied systemic insecticides

- Admire Pro (imidacloprid)
- Platinum 75 SG (thiamethoxam)
- Belay 50 WDG (clothianidin)
- Verimark (cyazypyr)
 - Non-bearing use only (Belay and Verimark)

Foliar-applied insecticides

- Provado (imidacloprid)
- Danitol (fenpropathrin)
- Lorsban (chlorpyrifos)
- Delegate (spinetoram)
- Movento (spirotetramat)
- Exirel (Cyazypyr)
